DELINEATION AND PROTECTIVE DEVICES PERMITTED FOR USE IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY

The City of Naples requires homeowners to apply for and obtain a permit for items placed in the public right-of-way to preserve public safety and the character of the community. Delineation and protective devices may be used subsequent to City approval of a site-specific right-of-way permit application. Right-of-way application fees may be waived for protective devices.

Port Royal has adapted the City's requirements for protective devices that may be temporarily used during neighborhood construction activities that may indirectly damage greenscaped areas within the public right-of-way:

- 2 – 3' plastic PVC pipe installed no greater than 42" vertically above surrounding ground surface and placed 18" horizontally from the edge of existing pavement.
- PVC pipes must be placed 8 feet apart on center.
- Pipes must be black and capped with a plastic acorn finial.
- Chains are not permitted between pipes.
- Maintain 2" bands of reflective tape (white) around the circumference of each installed pipe no greater than 8 inches from the capped top.
