

#### CIVIC ADVOCACY

We actively monitor and respond to city initiatives that impact Port Royal. The Association continues to oppose the rerouting of Naples Airport traffic over our neighborhood and blocked proposed land use changes that would have harmed property values. We also work with the city to ensure roads, medians, and public landscaping within our boundaries are properly maintained

#### UTILITIES

The Association is leading the conversion of all overhead power lines to underground service, improving both reliability and aesthetics, with upgraded street lighting included in the project. We are also working to bring natural gas and high-speed fiber optic internet to the community to provide safer, more efficient energy and better connectivity.

#### LANDSCAPING & GROUNDS

The Association maintains and enhances Port Royal's main entrances, including landscaping, enhancements, and irrigation. While interior green spaces are managed by the City of Naples, we continue to coordinate with city staff to ensure proper replanting, particularly after recent storm damage, and collaborate on any landscape improvements to our common spaces. Seasonal holiday décor is also installed by the Association at our main entrances each year.

#### **SECURITY**

The Association contracts with the Naples Police Department and Port Royal Security to provide nightly visible security at the entrance to our community. Since implementation, this extra level of security has brought our crime incidents down to the lowest of any community in Naples. We have also funded license plate reading cameras at each of our entrances to further monitor our streets. Funding this security is a material portion of our budget. Keeping our neighborhood and public roads safe and secure is an ongoing and top priority.

#### DEED AND CODE COMPLIANCE

The Architectural Review and Building Committee reviews all construction and shoreline projects to ensure compliance with our community Deed Restrictions and City Ordinances. This oversight protects property values, preserves community standards, and ensures all builders and architects follow established approval procedures.
